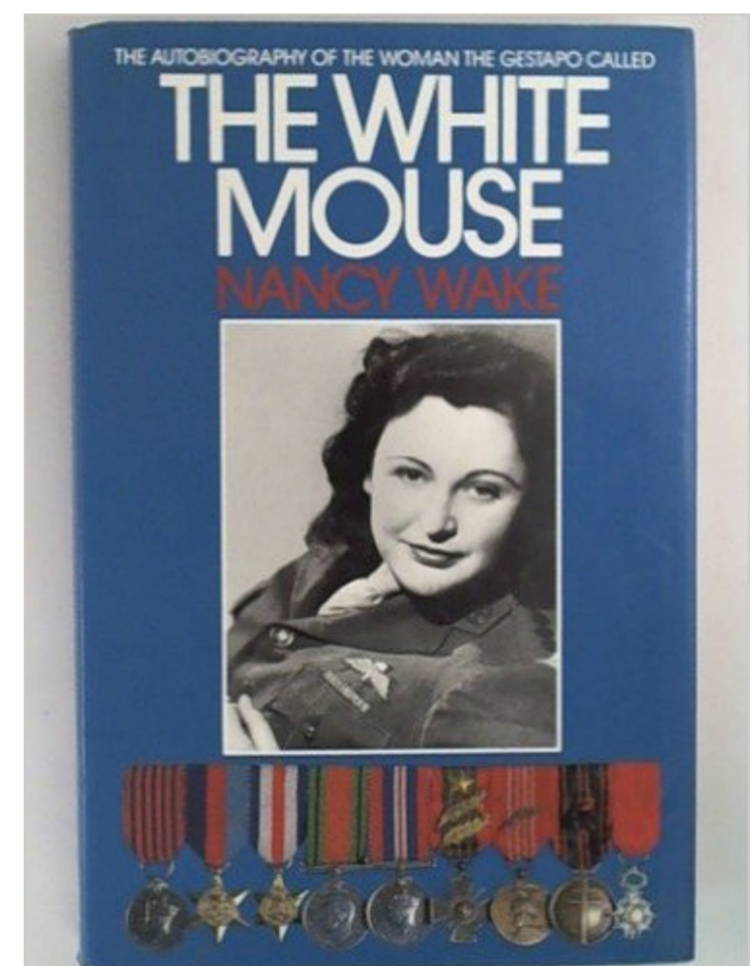


The marriage at Cana of Galilee
