

# Movie Star Extraordinaire



**ERROL FLYNN** the world-renowned movie star grew up at Mclean Ave Chatswood. In 1926 he attended the Sydney Church of England Grammar School (in Centennial Avenue, Chatswood) where he was the classmate of future Australian Prime Minister, John Gorton. He was expelled for fighting and, allegedly, having sex with a school laundress. He was also expelled from several other schools he had attended in Tasmania. At the age of 20 he moved to New Guinea where he bought a tobacco plantation, a business which failed. A copper mining venture in the hills near the Laloki Valley, behind the present national capital, Port Moresby, also failed.
