**QUENTIN DEMPSTER** lived in St Leonards and worked as an ABC political reporter, current affairs presenter and investigative journalist. He wrote about the shooting of police whistle-blower **Michael Drury** in 1984.

After Drury recovered from his injuries he stated that there was no doubt in his mind that another policeman was involved in his shooting: **Roger Rogerson**. In 1989, Rogerson was charged with conspiring with two criminals - **Chris "Rent-a Kill" Flannery** and **Alan Williams**, to murder Drury. He was subsequently acquitted.

Michael Drury, a Sydney undercover detective, was in the kitchen of his house in Neridah Street, Chatswood, on the evening of 6 June 1984...He felt an agonising pain in his stomach, then another in the side of his chest...'I think I've been shot'... Drury was in intensive care at the Royal North Shore for weeks"
