ROGER WOODWARD was born in Chatswood. He studied church music with **Kenneth Long** in Sydney and at the New South Wales State Conservatorium of Music; conducting with **Sir Eugene Goossens**; piano with **Alexander Sverjensky** and composition with **Raymond Hanson**. He won the piano section of the 1964 ABC Instrumental and Vocal Competition, beating **David Helfgott** in the final.

BERNARD PATRICK 'DOC' NEESON is associated with Willoughby. He was an Australian singer-songwriter and musician. The front man for the hard rock band The Angels from its formation in February 1976 to their disbandment in December 1999. For the group, Neeson was the main lyricist with brothers **John and Rick Brewster** as the music composers.

At the 1988 ARIA Awards the group were inducted into the Rock Hall of Fame. In early December 1999, Neeson had a car accident on the Sydney M4 motorway. Later that month The Angels disbanded. In 2013 Neeson's had been diagnosed with a brain tumour. He died in 2014.



BAMBI TUCKWELL or Patricia Elizabeth Lascelles, Dowager Countess of Harewood is an Australian violinist and former fashion model. She is the widow of **George Lascelles**, 7th Earl of Harewood, eldest paternal first cousin of **Queen Elizabeth II** and the daughter of musician **Charles Tuckwell**. She was a violinist for the Sydney Symphony Orchestra and also a fashion model.
