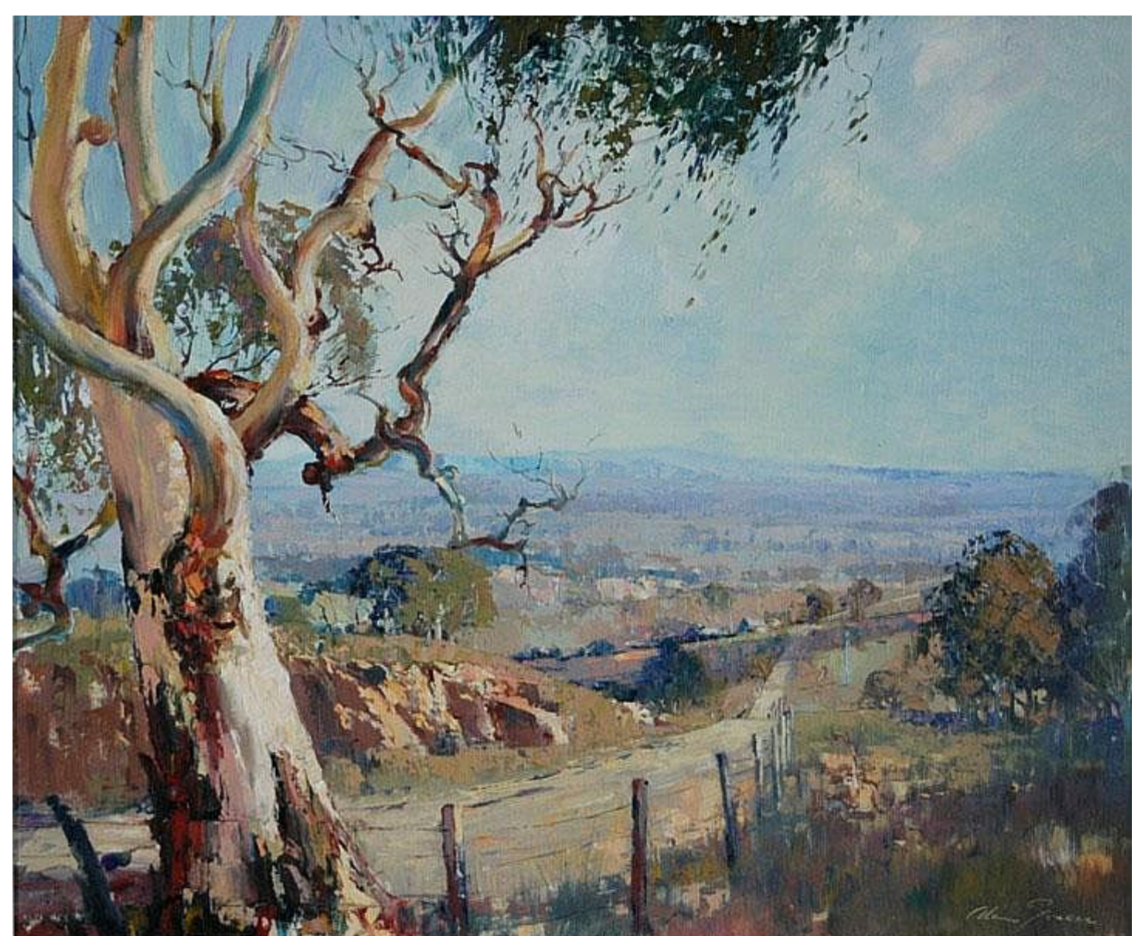
Philosophy by Lionel Lindsay
