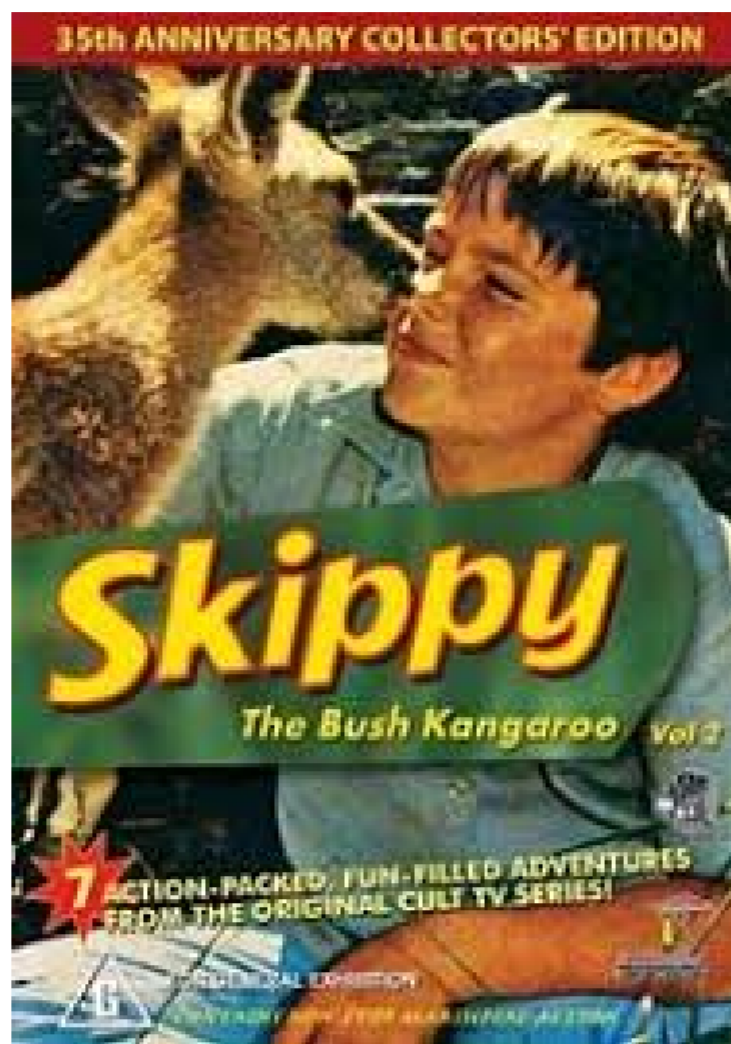


# Film Editor

**ERNIE HILTON BELLING** from Artarmon was a film editor on the long-running TV serial 'Skippy'. He edited 39 episodes between 1968 and 1970.

Skippy the Bush Kangaroo (known commonly as Skippy) was an Australian television series created by Australian actor John McCallum, produced from 1967–1969 (airing from 1968–1970) about the adventures of a young boy and his intelligent pet kangaroo, and the various visitors to the fictional Waratah National Park in Duffys Forest, near Sydney.

Ninety-one 30-minute episodes were produced. Additionally, a full-length movie titled Skippy and The Intruders was released to theaters in 1969. The show was filmed in colour and after airing in its home country, it was shown in the United Kingdom, Canada and the Netherlands, where it was first screened between 1969 and 1972. The Nine Network readily repeated the series several times after Australian television switched to colour transmission in 1975.
