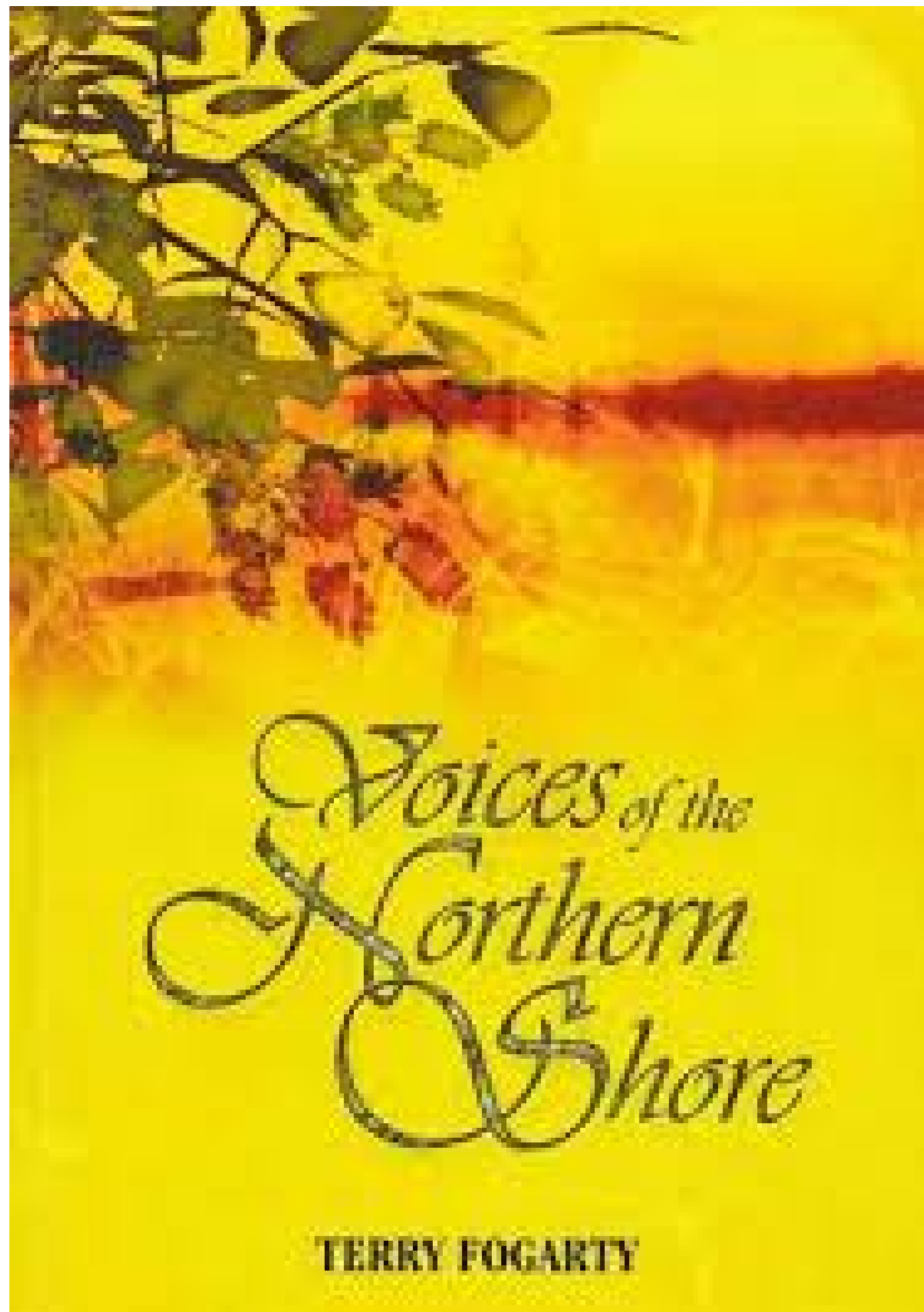


Voices of the Northern Shore



Edited by **TERRY FOGARTY**, *Voices of the Northern Shore* is a Literary Gazetteer of the hundreds of poets and authors who have 'touched' the North Shore of Sydney. The book is arranged by suburb. Each entry contains some short biographical detail of the writer, an excerpt of their work (particularly if it shows their connection to the North Shore) and a list of their published works.

Voices fills a void in the cultural history of Sydney. The Northern Shore is rich in writers from a wide range of genre. Not since the Oxford Literary Guide to Australia has there been a comprehensive attempt to capture a sense of place embodied in the works of many of our local writers.
